## **EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR SEARCH TO COMMENCE**

After four years at the helm of the Pennsylvania Chamber Orchestra, I will be stepping down as Executive Director at the end of this season. It has been an absolute pleasure to work with the entire PCO family of musicians, donors, patrons, and board members during my tenure.

Back in early 2018, I had just moved to State College from New Jersey and knew virtually no one in Centre County, let alone Pennsylvania. I was introduced to the PCO when I was invited to serve as a substitute in the horn section for a Beethoven concert. Because of the connections I made at that concert, I took over the reins as ED later that year during the holiday concert week. It was a whirlwind, to say the least! Despite feeling as though I didn't know what I was doing, the transition went smoothly thanks to the careful preparations of Susan Kroeker, my predecessor.

The last few years have been as wonderful (and occasionally as hectic) as that first week. We have contended with canceled concerts due to Covid, an entirely virtual season, and the gradual return to the concert hall in 2021. It is my hope that by announcing my intention to step away from

PCO now, the board of directors can conduct a thorough search, and we will be able to complete a seamless transition.

I'm confident that the search committee will identify a great new Executive Director. Stay tuned for updates on the position posting and timeline. If you or someone you know might be interested in applying, please let us know. Thank you for letting me be part of the PCO family!

# A CALL FOR SUPPORT IN THE SEASON OF GIVING


