SAVE THE DATES FOR CENTRE GIVES 2022

Centre Gives 2022 is coming up quickly on May 10-11 and is a great opportunity to stretch your donation dollars. The PCO has received an amazing showing of support from donors during Centre Gives in the past and we hope you will think of us again this year as you support all your favorite Centre County non-profits.

New to Centre Gives? Here is what you need to know.

- Centre Gives is a 36-hour online giving event that begins at 9am on May 10 concludes at 9pm on May 11 and takes place at CentreGives.org.
- The minimum donation is \$10. All donations must be via credit or debit card (Visa, MasterCard, Discover, or American Express).
- All donations are tax-deductible. You will receive a tax receipt from Centre Foundation.
- Your donations these 36 hours are stretched beyond the initial dollar amount as participating organizations receive a percentage of a \$200,000 stretch pool, plus a portion of an additional \$100,000 bonus pool.
- Organizations may receive specific prizes throughout the event by participating in certain events or challenges. Check out centregives.org/prizes to see all available prizes.

A silent auction and raffle will be held to benefit the orchestra. Visit pachamberorchestra.org/ to see a list of donors and items closer to the event.




A CALL FOR SUPPORT
